Serving in: Caronport SK with OM Canada

In January, Brent attended two Missions Conferences, one at Millar Bible College and one at Nipawin Bible College. Both conferences were very In February, Brent spoke in a chapel service at Eston College in Regina. Once again he was able to make some good connections with students and staff. Brent also had his monthly OMC stand at Briercrest as he continues to engage with students. Brent also met with organizers from the Billy Graham Association who planning a two-day celebration in Regina (June 2026) with Will Graham as the speaker (Billy Graham's grandson). Brent met to see how OM Canada can support this city-wide evangelistic event. As a follow up, in March Brent attended a Pastors/church leaders' breakfast in Regina in March. Pray for Wisdom as Brent looks for ways to collaborate with this event. Then last weekend, Brent was in Saskatoon for the "Inspire the Nation" youth event. Over 1000 young people gathered together for inspiring worship, testimonies and to listen to God's word being preached. There were around 15 mission agencies (including OM) who were there and spent time with the young people in all the breaks and before/after the main sessions. It was a very busy 24 hrs.
God has asked us to be faithful to what he has called us to do and the eternal results are in His Hands.
