Here we are, mid-November, in the middle of another growing season in Nicaragua. It's a favourite time of year - 2 months of steady rains have replenished the soil. Now that the rains have slowed, everything is green and lush. Every member of the La Semilla team is out and about - sharing, teaching, and encouraging about faith and farming. It's amazing how well those two themes work together! It's easy to stand in a lush field and talk about God the Creator and how He welcomes us into relationship with Him. It's equally natural to talk about agriculture - the care and nurturing of seeds & plants - and relate the processes of crop development to steps of faith that each one of us must take to become more complete images of God in our every-day.

Still, both one of these topics require boldness and courage to consider changes in our lives. As human beings, we naturally resist change. Considering farming practices, it takes many conversations and sometimes years before we see general adoption of new technologies. When we talk about faith, the idea of a personal relationship with God is sometimes difficult compute. Religion and law are often easier to understand, but not the acts of obedience and transformation that Jesus calls us to, the liberty that He gives.

So, whether it's faith or farming, one must be bold and courageous to move forward! We walk with Nicaraguans in relationship so that the decisions can be made a little easier. Opportunities abound to share the love of God in practical and meaningful ways!
