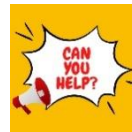

When we were in T-, a little girl with us had trouble sleeping because she had been taught to sleep in a room with no windows to be safe from Russian missiles. But all the bedrooms in T- had windows! She grabbed a blanket and slept on the floor in a corner. But by the end of the trip, she was sleeping in bed with her mother! Pray for the Ukrainian kids struck with fear. They live in a constant threat of danger.

We had our first big meeting during a festival where we met with approx. 200 Crimean Tatars! Thank you Lord. By the end of our time in T-, we were all very tired and concluded short term ministry trips are very exhausting!
