Serving in: South Asia with Global Outreach Mission

After meeting with our mission agency, MissionGO, and with their permission, our family will be taking an extended furlough in Canada. We've determined that this is the best course for our family's well-being at this time – and for both of us we plan to work on our continued Biblical education.



While we are pursuing further education in North America, our ministry in South Asia will be maintained by our current staff members. Our team of nearly 28 dedicated staff members continues to serve faithfully. We also work with the tribal communities in North India. We humbly ask for your prayers for two specific regions where we are actively sharing the Gospel. Our ministry reaches across:

- Three branch churches
- Two pastor fellowships, gathering nearly 200 pastors
- A blind ministry serving 100 individuals
- A women's ministry for pastors' wives, with 80 women gathering regularly

With these changes, we will still need your ongoing prayer and financial support. We ask for additional prayers during this transition for us and our children.
