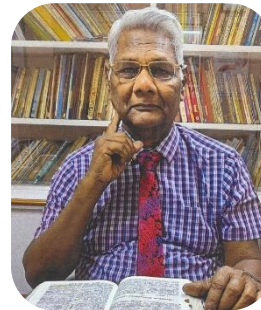


Missionary of the Week
